General

- Electric
 - Power comes up the road (buried in center) to the utility vault at the edge of the road and where our property meets the neighbors driveway in the NW section. From there to the NW corner of our house.
 - There are two electric meters, one is for the well. We split the cost of the electricity, though we haven't really used enough to make it worth tracking yet.
- Water
 - Well is located on the West side of the house and goes from there to the blue pressure tank in the garage.
 - Well water is shared with the neighbor to the West.
 - Frig is plumbed for an ice maker.
 - no disposal in kitchen sink (we're on septic)

- built-in dishwasher
- Water has been tested by Always Pure and you have the report. They actually used the word 'amazing'.
- Sewer
 - septic tank outside of the NW corner of house and has just been inspected and pumped by Lil Stinky
 - septic alarm on NW corner of house near electric meters.
 - sand filter across road up the hill about 20 yards.
 - drainfield in the NE section of property
- Phone
 - analog line for security system and because of marginal cell service.
 - cell phone reception spotty 1-2 bars in driveway or on back porch, but not much in the house. Verizon works best.
- Internet
 - DSL line x 2.. Cat5 cable strung under the house to each of the other bedrooms and kitchen for wireless access points.
- TV
 - We haven't had tv for a few years, but both Dish and Direct satellite come in well. All bedrooms and great room wired with coaxial jacks for tv.
 - media box in 3rd bedroom closet is junction for coax cable.
- Trash
 - \circ no garbage service back here. you go to the Sandy Transfer Station by Shorty's Corner.
- Road
 - easement for the five houses on this side of the bridge. We generally split the costs but it's a causal arrangement.
 - County maintenance from Coleman to the mailboxes where you turn 90 degrees to the left. After that it's on us.
 - Gate at the bridge is an expense shared by the five of us on this side of it. Cost of repairs and electricity split by all of us. We usually call the cost of gate electricity a wash with the neighbor to the West for the cost of well electricity.
- Security
 - 24/7 monitoring by Protection One.
 - Keypad in hallway by front door.
 - All doors and windows on system (not garage doors, but door from garage to laundry room). Motion detector above guest bath.
 - Hardwired in during construction (not wireless).
 - Security system 'brain' located in master bedroom closet.
- Audio/Video
 - 5.1 surround sound speakers in great room
 - 2 outside speakers on deck.
 - Jacks for all are behind tv in great room.
- Central vac
 - Ports at each end of the hallway and one in the kitchen on the baseboard that you use with your foot. It's pretty cool.
- HVAC
 - Electric furnace in garage.
 - Heat pump on East side of house for central air conditioning.

- Air return above pantry in great room to capture hot air from woodstove to circulate it throughout the house.
- Earthstove 1500HT woodstove easily heats entire great room.
- Programmable thermostat in hallway near master bedroom.
