When Marmot Dam Blew - Where'd the Dam sediment go?

Saturday August 21 2-4 p.m.

At the Former Marmot Dam Site

(Hwy 26 to Ten Eyck Rd. to Marmot Rd.)

The 2007 removal of PGE's Marmot Dam from the Sandy River returned miles of salmon habitat to free-flowing condition but released nearly a million cubic yards of sediment in the process. Join the Sandy River Basin Watershed Council and river scientists at the former dam site for a non-technical tour of where the sediment is now and how Marmot Dam's removal influences the Sandy River's ecology.
